As a TITLE I SCHOOLWIDE DISTRICT the LEA's Federal Programs Coordinator is responsible for overseeing compliance with the No Child Left Behind Law and the management of funds governed by the EVERY STUDENT SUCCEEDS ACT (ESSA) specifically Title I, Title II, and School Improvement Grants (both formula and competitive). Moreover, the FPC provides technical assistance to all staff, parents and community members in regards to state and federal laws corresponding to these programs. The FPC also coordinates Title I services for our students attending non-public schools.

Goals of the Federal Programs Coordinator: To provide technical assistance, analysis and interpretation of ESSA as it relates to Title I to administrative offices, Principals and school based staff.

1. To submit applications to the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) for all grants related to Title I, including the School Improvement Grants.
2. To provide support and technical assistance to schools related to expenditures of Title I and School Improvement Grants to help schools and students achieve at higher levels.
3. To provide support and technical assistance to schools as they complete the School Improvement Planning process.
4. To coordinate Title I services for students that attend non-public or Diocesan schools.
