The following is intended as a summary of significant actions taken at the meeting of the Board of Directors of the Aliquippa School District held on Wednesday, June 21, 2017. The meeting was called to order at 6:00p.m.

1. Approved minutes of the May 10 and May 17, 2017 board meetings.
2. Approved Mrs. LeeAnn Prodonovich as Board Secretary for a four year (4) term effective July 1, 2017 through and including June 30, 2021. Salary is \$1,800.00 per year.
3. Approved a Memorandum of Understanding with the City of Aliquippa Police Department as required by the Safe School Act.
4. Approved Mr. John F. Salopek, Esquire as the Solicitor for the Aliquippa School District, effective July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018.
5. Ratified an affiliation agreement between the Aliquippa School District and Slippery Rock University for field placement of student teachers, effective June 1, 2017 through and including May 31, 2022 for a term of five (5) years. This agreement may be terminated by either party with ninety (90 days) notice.
6. Accept/approve the following:
 - a) Treasurer's Report – May 2017.
 - b) Report of Taxes Collected – May 2017.
 - c) Report of Delinquent Property Tax Collections – May 2017.
 - d) General Fund Financial Statements – May 2017.
 - e) Cafeteria Fund Financial Statements – May 2017.
7. Approved General Fund disbursements in the amount of **\$312,340.39** for June 2017.
8. Ratified General Fund disbursements in the amount of **\$1,707,799.27** for May 2017.
9. Approved Cafeteria Fund disbursements in the amount of **\$14,992.00** for June 2017.
10. Adopted the proposed General Fund Budget for the 2017-2018 School Year in the amount of \$22,554,786.00.

11. Approved Services Agreement Reinstatement with The Omni Group for the continuation of 403(b)/457(b) administration services, effective July 1, 2017 through and including June 30, 2018 at a cost of \$1,608.00. This is no increase in the cost.
12. Approved approve renewal of Kelly Services for the teacher substitute services for the 2017-2018 school year. All terms and conditions will remain at a rate of \$119.00/day. The agreement is for a one (1) year period, July 1, 2017 through and including June 30, 2018.

13. Approved Mr. Johnathan Senko and Ms. Lori Mills as the Aliquippa School District website facilitators for the 2017-2018 School year at a rate of \$1,500.00 per facilitator. There is no increase in the rate.
14. Approved an agreement with the Meadows Psychiatric Behavioral Health center at a rate of \$65.00/day for educational services on an as needed basis for the 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 School Years. The agreement may be terminated by either party by a 30 day written notice. This represents an increase of \$5.00 per day.
15. Approved an agreement between the Aliquippa School District and CDW-G for the 2017-2018 School year to provide Impero Education Pro at a rate of \$3,010.00. This represents a decrease of \$1,498.00 from the prior year. This will be paid through the technology budget.
