

Local Fence Association donates new fence to school district

Aliquippa, PA— 8-9-24 — On Thursday, August 1st, the Western PA/West Virginia chapter of the American Fence Association (AFA) installed 280' feet of galvanized chain link fence at Aliquippa high school, famous for producing the most (3) Hall of Fame NFL players.

“I’ve never seen this much fence go up so fast,” said Harrison Dover, Chapter President and Sales Manager for SRF Fence/Trex. “The project had elevation changes and went along a steep hillside. It’ll be much safer for children and the visitors of Heinz Field moving forward.”

All the fence framework, or pipe, for the job was donated by the Aliquippa branch of Master Halco which is located a few miles from the project on Steel St. The WPA/WV AFA chapter funded the remaining fabric, fittings and accessories.

“We’re proud to support our local fence association and the Aliquippa school district on this chapter project,” said Patrick Williams, Branch Manager, Master Halco.

Crews and personnel from over 7 different fence companies donate all the labor.
