Dear Aliquippa Parents & Families,

This week we were informed of a positive Covid case in Aliquippa Jr. Sr. High School. The individual was last in school on **Friday, September 3rd, 2021** and reported the positive test result on **Friday, September 10.**

As part of the contact tracing protocol, anyone who had close contact with the individual, has been asked to self-quarantine for 10-14 days from the time of exposure unless they are fully vaccinated. Per the CDC, close contact is defined as any individual within 6-feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes or more over a 24 hour period. We have conducted an investigation to determine students and staff who may have had close contact with the individual who tested positive and these individuals have been notified. Additionally, all infected work areas and supplies have been disinfected per CDC guidelines.

People who are fully vaccinated do not need to quarantine after contact with someone who has Covid-19 unless they demonstrate symptoms. However, fully vaccinated individuals should get tested 2-5 days after their exposure even if they do not show symptoms and wear a mask indoors in public for 14 days following exposure or until their test result is negative.

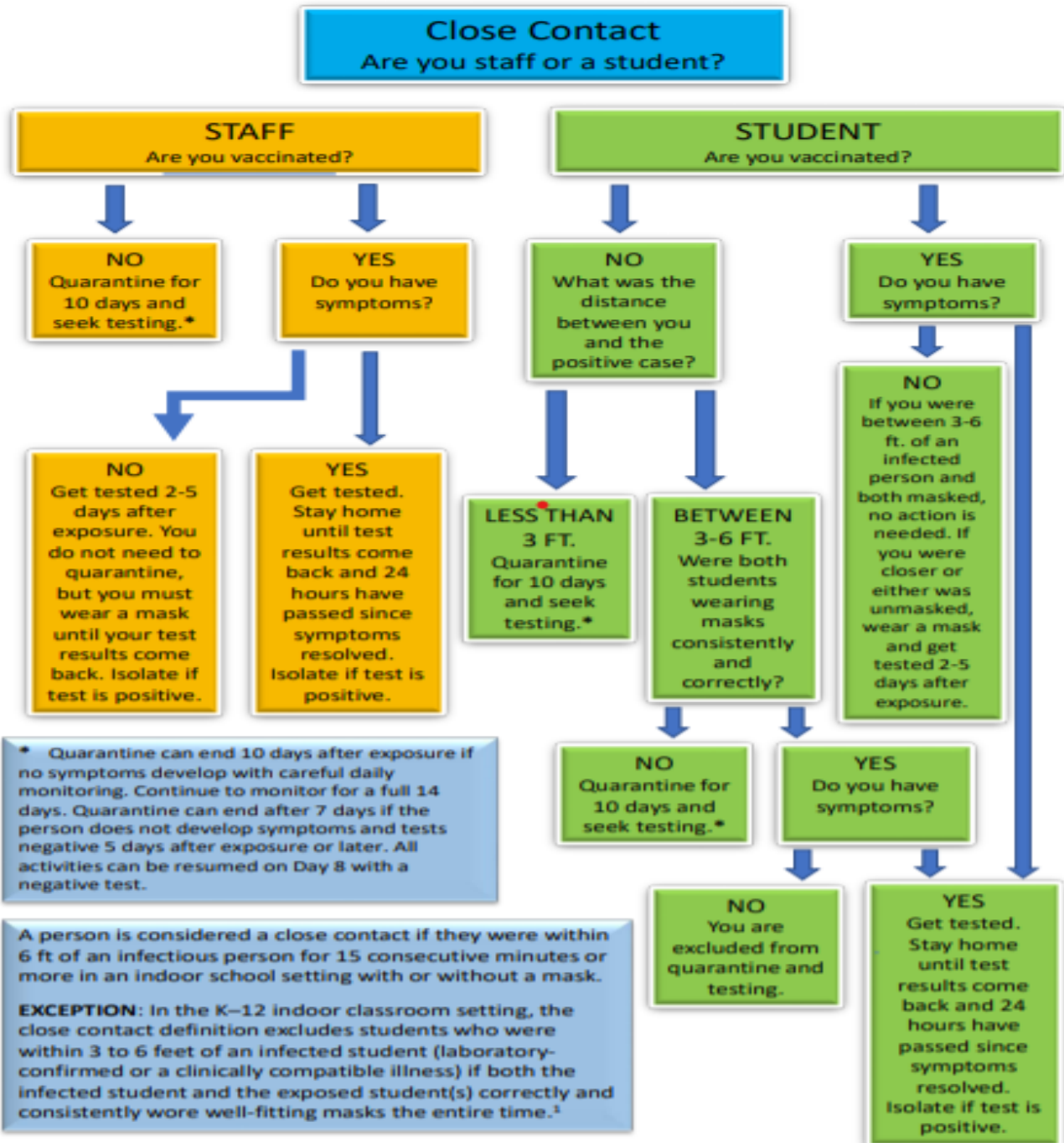
